Manuscripts are accepted in English or Ukrainian and must be submitted via e-mail to mammalia@ukr.net by the corresponding author. Submission and publication of articles are free of charge.

The Editorial Board ensures the highest standards of academic ethics an a consistent and fair editorial policy. Peer-rewiev is single blind, and authors must submit a conflict of interest statement prior to publication.
